Answer the question.



1. 2 rabbits jumped out of Marvin's hat. 6 more rabbits jumped out of another hat.
How many rabbits were there in all?



There were eight rabbits in all.

2. There were 9 children watching Marvin. 5 children walked out to get a snack.
How many children were left?

3. Marvin had 5 apples for his magic trick. He bought some more. Now he has 11.
How many apples did Marvin buy?

Answer Key
1. $2 + 6 = 8$. There were 8 rabbits in all. 2. $9 - 5 = 4$. There were 4 children left. 3. $5 + 6 = 11$. He bought 6 apples.
